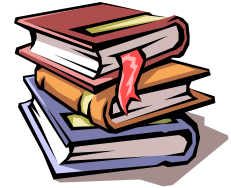

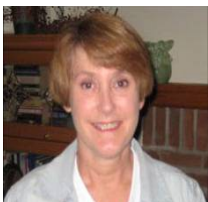

Jeannette Tate (Washington/Wilson Vance) gave birth to a son, James Harrold on June 8.

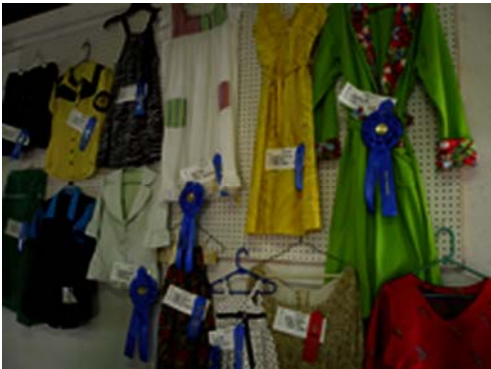
